RE: Monthly Report of Activities for Board meeting on 8/18/2022

- For the month of August, the Wastewater Treatment Facility had two exceedances of its N.P.D.E.S. permit. Total coliform of 46 MPN on 7/7, this was believed to be caused by particles in the water after cleaning the UV system and restarting the system back-up to quickly. Also, a 7.8 MPN on 7/20, this is an unknown cause none of the system's numbers were out of range. Both cause seven-day median exceedances in the Permit.
- Plant Staff installed new filter panels in the filters and cleaned the UV system to keep both systems running efficiently.
- Rio Del Oro Lift station; Staff has been checking all equipment at Rio Del Oro lift station on a regular basis.
- The odor control project for lift station 14 (Zanes and River Oaks) was started on July 14th. It has hit a snag. The company is extending the trial because the H2s reading went all the way back to the original test result. They are working on finding what's gone wrong.
- Staff has had to put work into looking for I&I problems with the collection system on hold because of short Staff and workload on doing inspections for the District.
- Estimated Plant processed for the month of August was 42.8 MG.
