RE: Monthly Report of Activities for Board meeting on 2/15/2024

- ➤ For the month of December the Wastewater Treatment Facility had no exceedances of its N.P.D.E.S. permit.
- ➤ Plant Staff cleaned the filters and the UV system to keep both systems running efficiently.
- ➤ Rio Del Oro Lift station: Staff has been checking all equipment at Rio Del Oro lift station on a regular basis.
- > Staff installed new upgrade kits for the return sludge and wasting pumps. These kits are designed to run more efficiently and not get clogged up with rags.
- ➤ Some of the parts for the bar screen repair have arrived on site. It is tentatively scheduled to be repaired the week of Feb 12th.
- ➤ Lift Station 14: Staff has been water flushing bi-weekly at lift station 14. Staff has also been doing a caustic flush on a monthly basis to help alleviate the hydrogen sulfide. Staff is also testing and recording the hydrogen sulfide numbers 2-3 times a week.
- > Staff has had to put work into looking for I&I problems with the collection system on hold because of Staff is gearing up to commence cleaning the collection system down in Plumas Lake area.
- ➤ The Waste Water Plant processed for the month of November was 49.57 million gallons, which is an average of 1.60 MGD flow.
