Meeting Date: May 16, 2019

Consider selection of a service provider for the OPUD Website. (Strategic Plan 2018-2023, 2.4).

District Clerk and Public Works Administrative Assistant have been reviewing and conversing with service providers to determine which option best fits the needs of the District. District Clerk presented a spreadsheet of options to Directors at the February Regular Board Meeting, and was instructed to reach out to two of the providers for updated quotes and references. Staff received reference lists from the two final options, and have made contact with clients that utilize those services to gauge their level of satisfaction. Staff ask that the Board select a service provider from the final two options so that a contract can be presented for approval at the June Board Meeting.

Fiscal Analysis:

WISR estimated that setup would cost \$4,685, hosting and security would cost approximately \$79 per month, and that ongoing support would be charged at an hourly rate. Streamline estimated that setup would cost \$2,000, and that the \$300 monthly fee would cover the cost of host, security, updates, compliance, and support. Based on the option selected in an abundance of caution, I recommend that we allocate \$6,000 in the FY 2019-20 budget for the expense in the Administrative budget, which is further spread across all departments.

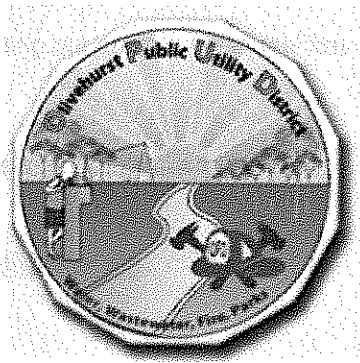

1. OPUD Website upgrade construction and deployment to be performed by WISR.
2. WISR will perform design, development and build on WISR servers.
3. OPUD decision-making personnel will be reasonably available for consultation and site construction approval.
4. Mobile device compatibility will be dependent on the selected WordPress template.
5. OpenSource technology is to be used as the core website technology wherever possible.
6. WordPress is to be used for the core Content Management System (CMS).
7. From time-to-time, commercial "Add-On" components may be recommended by WISR to enhance basic WordPress functionality. These commercial add-ons will be described to OPUD, and OPUD will have the option to purchase any recommended add-on.
8. WISR has final technical approval on the selection of any WordPress add-on or extra component for inclusion to the final OPUD website. WISR's main criteria for inclusion or exclusion of an add-on will be system usability, stability and security.
9. This Quote assumes no modification to chosen WordPress template except those properties designed to be configurable from within Template Framework Administration area.
10. OPUD personnel will be reasonably available for site and system testing.
11. All Graphics will be provided "site ready" or created by an art designer approved by OPUD & WISR.
12. Data from OPUD's Joomla v.2.5 site may be difficult to transfer to the WordPress site. The exact handling of this data may require the help of OPUD personnel.
13. WISR will have access to current OPUD Joomla 2.5.x site with FTP or Control Panel access with Administrator Username and Password.
14. WISR has appropriate access to OPUD's third-party systems that will be integrated into the new WordPress site; e.g. Domain Registrar, SEO, Google accounts, etc.
15. This quote does not include the migration of current "Poll" components.

3. OPUD can begin reviewing possible designs, themes, components, etc.

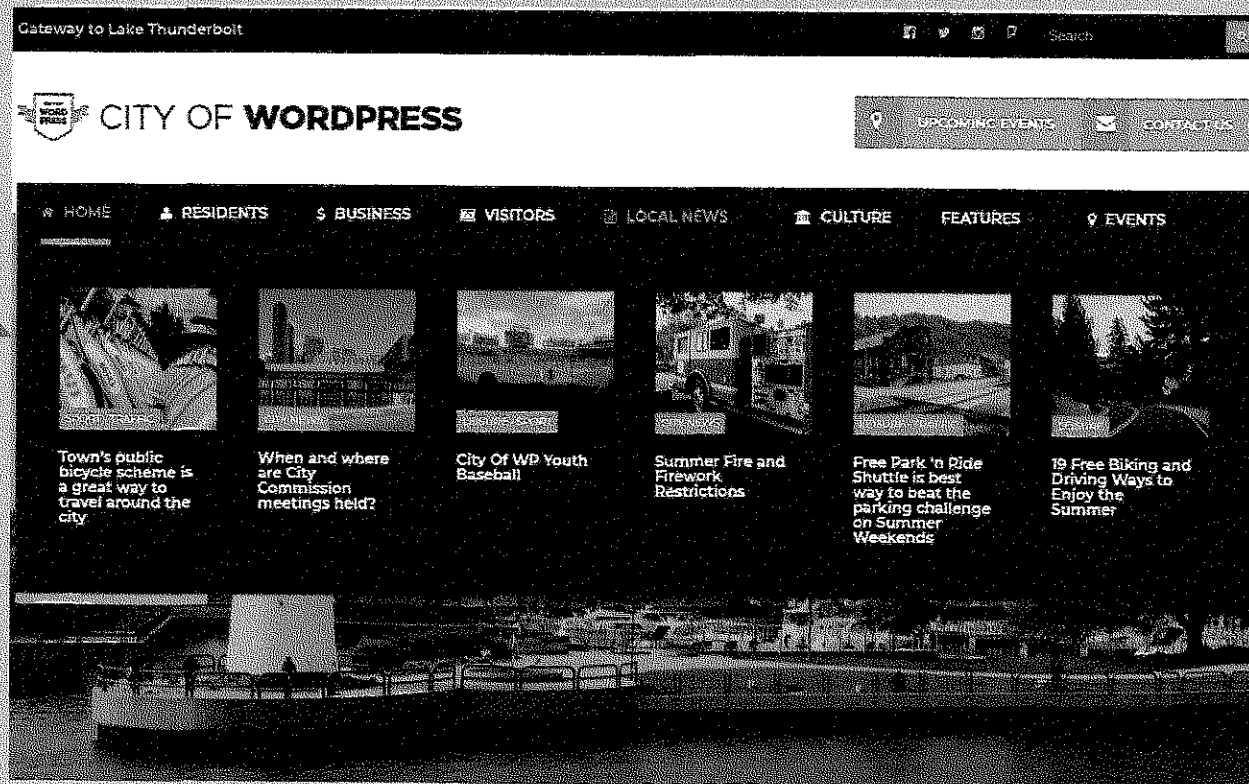


