Item description/summary:				
Consider Budget Amendment for Water and Sewer County Relocations as part of South County				
Project.				
Olivehurst Public Utility District (OPUD) has been working with Yuba County in order to get Sewer and Water extension down on McGowan and Highway 65 & 70 as part of an existing Grant that Yuba County was approved for Street and Storm Drain Improvements. Fortunate for OPUD, Sewer extension and Water Main Extension was covered under the Grant, but OPUD had to cover existing relocation cost due to street improvements and Storm Drain updates and new infrastructure for County Project. The cost of relocations totals \$251,810, which will require a budget amendment to the existing Water and Sewer Relocation budget for County Projects.				
Fiscal Analysis:				
OPUD reserves roughly \$200,000 a year for County Relocation projects. This project alone is roughly \$250,810.				
Employee Feedback				
OPUD would need to do the Relocations regardless, the only difference is OPUD is under the bid that was sourced out by Yuba County, and they have final say on which bidder will do the work. The rate of relocation is slightly higher than OPUD projects, but in the long term, it is a cheaper alternative to go forward with the Yuba County Bid due to Grant coverage of the New Water and Sewer Infrastructure.

Bids are to be submitted for the entire work. The amount of the bid for comparison purposes will be the total of all items. The bidder shall set forth for each item of work, in clearly legible figures, an item price and a total for the item in the respective spaces provided for this purpose. In the case of unit basis items, the amount set forth under the "Total" column shall be the product of the item price bid on the basis of the estimated quantity for the item.

In case of discrepancy between the item price and the total set forth for a unit basis item, the unit item price shall prevail, except as provided in (a) or (b), as follows:

- (a). If the amount set forth as a unit price is unreadable or otherwise unclear, or is omitted, or is the same as the amount as the entry in the item total column, then the amount set forth in the item total column for the item shall prevail and shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the unit price.
- (b). If both the item price and total are unreadable or otherwise unclear, or are omitted, the bid may be deemed irregular.

The decision of the County of Yuba respecting the amount of a bid, or the existence or treatment of an irregularity in a bid, shall be final.

- (3) To insert the substance of the provisions of this clause in all subcontracts issued pursuant to this contract.

13. Add to section 39-2.01C(9):

The minimum subgrade for HMA ramps shall be 6" of aggregate. The cost for aggregate base will be included in the contract price for aggregate base.

Place nonwoven, permeable, polypropylene geotextile fabric between the bedding zone and backfill materials for the full width and length of the storm drain trench, for trenching in the existing roadway, if crushed rock is used for bedding zone. Geotextile fabric shall comply with Section 96. Placement of the geotextile fabric shall comply with Section 19-10.03A. Payment for plastic pipe includes the cost for geotextile fabric.

- 16. Replace the Table of Contents with the revised Table of Content
- 17. Add new section 6-1.04D Polyvinyl Chloride Pipe and Cement

Polyvinyl Chloride Pipe and Cement must be produced in the United States.
