#### **CSA66 Parks Status**

Park Maintenance continues daily such as park checks, graffiti removal, weed pulling, trash dumping, ETC. The bathrooms in Eufay Woods Park are also being cleaned and sanitized daily. Monthly herbicide use reports delivered to County Agriculture Commissioner. In addition to general park maintenance the following has been completed.

All CSA 66 parks mowing and trimming as needed.

- **Tree/Trim work**: Eufay: trees trimmed; Rolling Hills and Orchard Glenn: Tree removed because it was falling down.
- Lawn/Weed work: Parks mowed, and weeds pulled. Rolling Hills: Lawn aeration and fertilizing completed. Eufay, Veterans, Brown, Orchard Glenn, River and River Glen: Fertilized

### • Irrigation:

Brown, Donahue, and Veteran's park: Water leak repaired.

Orchard Glenn: Four valves repaired.

Veteran's Park: One valve repaired.

River Glen: Solenoid repaired.

### Sprinklers repaired/replaced:

**Replaced:** Feather River: 16 sprinklers replaced; Bear River: 10 sprinkler replaced; Veterans: 9 sprinklers replaced, and 4 sprinklers capped off at baseball field.

Pinkerton: 2 sprinklers replaced; Brown: 10 sprinklers replaced; Eufay: 22 sprinklers replaced; Orchard Glenn: 13 sprinklers replaced; Rolling Hills: 7 sprinklers replaced; River: 7 sprinkler replaced; Joann: 3 sprinklers replaced; Donahue: 3 sprinklers replaced; Smith: 1 sprinkler replaced; River Glen: 9 sprinklers replaced.

**Repaired:** Feather River: 12 sprinklers repaired; Bear River: 20 sprinklers repaired; Veteran's: 8 sprinklers repaired; Pinkerton: 3 sprinklers repaired; Brown: 7 sprinklers repaired; Eufay: 10 sprinklers repaired; Orchard Glenn: 14 sprinklers repaired; Rolling Hills: 3 sprinklers repaired; River: 10 sprinklers repaired; Joann: 4 sprinklers repaired; River Glen: 8 sprinklers repaired and nozzle tips replaced on station 1 & 2 to reduce saturation; Donahue: 3 sprinklers repaired.

### • Equipment Maintenance:

Brown, Eufay, Rolling Hills, and Veteran's Parks: Well filters cleaned.

Bear River: Drinking fountain leak repaired.

Drinking fountain cleaned at all parks.

Brown and Donahue: Communications network was down, blue panel controller was not communicating with Laguna Rain Master. System updated by Rain Master, repairs and circuit board replaced by Site-one landscape.

Feather River: controller was not activating multiple sprinkler stations.

Eufay: GFI electrical outlet replaced. Drinking fountain unclogged and cleaned. Water Spray Park drains unclogged.

Joann: Park playground Seesaw Swivel removed, due to break at base.

Feather River, Eufay, Veterans, and Brown Parks: Playground equipment repaired.

• **Vandalism:** Broken glass removed from Eufay, Donahue, and River Glen Parks. Graffiti was removed at Bear River, Veteran's, Brown, Rolling Hills and River Glen Parks.

Trash can burned at River Glen Park.

Donahue Playground: Safety pole caps were removed.

• Safety: Traffic Safety, and Trench Safety.

### **Historic Olivehurst**

- **Tree/Trim work**: Tree branches trimmed at Johnson.
- **Lawn/Weed work:** Parks mowed and weeds pulled. Fertilized Lindhurst, Olivehurst, and Johnson Parks.

Irrigation: Water leak repaired at Becker Park.

**Replaced:** Tahiti: 10 sprinklers replaced; Olivehurst: 3 sprinklers replaced; Johnson: 4 sprinklers replaced; Becker: 6 sprinklers replaced.

**Repaired:** Olivehurst: 11 sprinklers repaired.

• **Equipment Maintenance:** Lindhurst: Water drains unclogged and cleaned. The water Spray Park is not fully functional and parts have been ordered (diaphragms eroded).

Olivehurst: Concrete picnic table bench removed, GFI outlet reset and water seal electrical box. Office rain gutter repaired.

• **Vandalism:** Graffiti removed at Tahiti, Johnson, Lindhurst, and Becker Parks.

Broken bottles removed at Johnson and Becker Parks.
