Item description/summary:

Consider Budget Amendment to repair existing Eufay Park one FasTalk modem. The existing Modem at Eufay Park is currently down. There are two communications hubs that communicate sprinkler systems; one at the water shop and one at Eufay Park. The main controls at the Water shop (its modem communicates with the modem in Eufay, which in returns sends signals to all Plumas Lake Park for sprinkler system controls.) The current modem at Eufay is down therefore no signals from the Water Shop is translated to Eufay so the sprinklers now have to be run manually by going to each park at Plumas Lake. This is an item that needs to be repaired asap to get the communication between parks in Plumas Lake back in running. This cost to repair the existing Modem is \$1,554. In the future (within next 24 months), I recommend moving forward with a cellular modem repeater at Eufay. This eliminates the outdated existing system with a more reliable communication system. The existing FasTalk modem no longer are produced and only way to fix any solutions is by repairing existing ones, as is the proposed method for time being until funds are allocated in advance cellular modem repeater. **Fiscal Analysis: Employee Feedback** n/a
