Item description/summary:

Billing Cycle Change Request: Per current billing cycle, water meters are read on the last of the month. Bills for usage are issued 15 days after the reading date and due 21 days later (on the 10th of the following month). Unpaid bills are subject to discontinuation 60 days after the due date. Staff request that bills are issued 7 days after the reading date and become due 30 days after the reading date (at month-end). This request will shorten the time between bill issuance and due date by 10 days and offset some of the delays in cash collections imposed by SB 998's guidelines. Attached are billing timelines pre SB 998, post SB 998 and proposed.

Note: Discontinuation of service for non-payment has been suspended during COVID 19 crisis

Fiscal Analysis:

There will be no additional charges to our customers. Bills are due earlier but closer to the actual usage month.

Earlier collections will result in better cashflow and liquidity for the Enterprise Funds' operating accounts.
