Building Permits	We have had 49 since the beginning of February.

	IRWMP administrators have guaranteed funding and we have the
	agreement signed so we will get the design started ASAP. CEQA
	and Design are started for both projects.
Parks Grants	We completed the application for the per capita Prop 68 grant
	and are currently out to bid for the project. Bids thus far have
	been too high.
Water Treatment	We are out to bid for the methane fans required by the state. We
Plants	received no bids for the project so are contacting contractors on
	our own to get the work done.
Parks Master	We are working with the OPUD parks consultant to finalize the
Plan	scope of the parks master plan update.
Water Capacity	The water capacity study has been started. We are collecting
Study	needed information for the consultant. We have a draft to review
	at this time.
Rate Study	The rate study is underway and we expect to have preliminary
	numbers soon.
Wastewater	The Board selected EPS/Jacobs Engineering to complete the
Capacity Fee	study.
